- Registration for Delhi Public School, Etah Chanakya Pathshala Scholarship Test-2025 [DPS CPST-2025] can be done online/offline up to 09-02-2025.**
- Payment of Registration Fee Rs. 100/- [Non-Refundable] can be made (Only in cash) up to 09/02/2025 (Sunday) at school fee counter, before the commencement of the exam CPST-2025.**
- Syllabus of DPS CPST-2025, for each grade, has been taken from the current curriculum, to take admission in the next class. The illustration, given below, can be considered for better understanding:
- Illustration 1:- Students studying in grade V will be examined on the basis of common and basic curriculum of the current grade i.e. Grade V to take admission in grade VI.  
Illustration 2:-Students studying in grade X will be examined on the basis of common and basic curriculum of the current grade i.e. Grade X to take admission in grade XI (Medical/Non-Medical / Commerce / Humanities).
- It's mandatory for the candidate to appear in his/her own current school uniform with school ID**

**card at DPS, Etah on 09-02-2025 one hour before the commencement of the exam.**

7. Pen/pencil/eraser/sharpener will be provided by the school in the examination room. A candidate needs not to carry anything except the school ID card/AADHAAR Card.
8. Electronic watches, calculator or any other electronic gadgets are strictly prohibited.
9. Candidates are not permitted to carry the DPS CPST-2025 question paper outside the examination room.
- 10. Result of CPST-2025 will be displayed on school notice board/website on 14-02-2025 (Friday).**
11. Qualifying the scholarship test is not an assurance for admission; it's solely a qualifying criterion.
12. Scholarship is awarded only on scoring 50 percent or above in DPS CPST-2025.
- 13. Scholarship is awarded to only those candidates who will take admission in DPS, Etah in next session i.e. 2025-26. It must be considered as NO CASH PRIZE.**
14. **ANY ONE SCHOLARSHIP** (whichever is greater in amount) will be awarded to a candidate.
15. Fulfilling the above conditions, the admission must be confirmed by the guardian on or before 8<sup>th</sup> March, 2025 depositing a token amount of Rs. 5000/- for each candidate.
